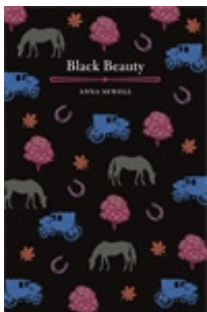

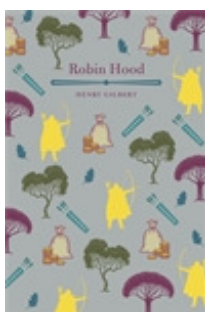
## Author Information

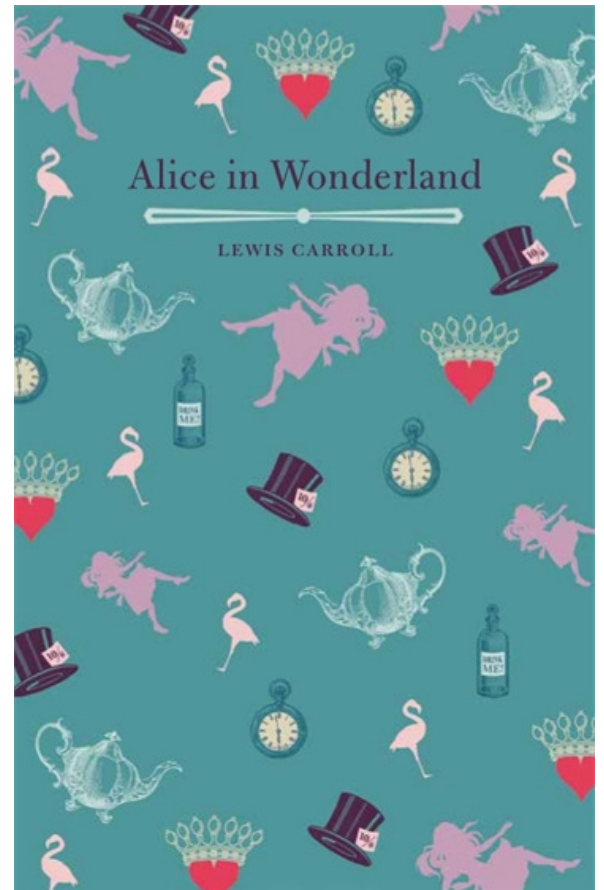
