AUTHOR BIOGRAPHY

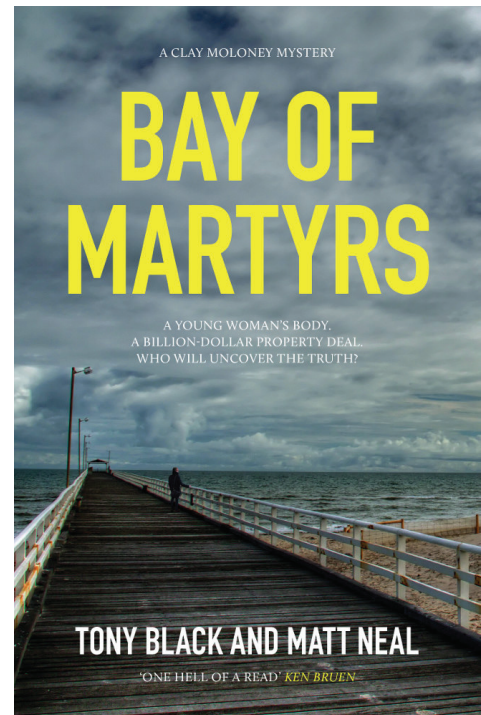
