This beautiful colouring book explores the wonderful imagination of Margaret Tarrant, who illustrated books, greetings cards and calendars for the Medici Society during the 1920s and 1930s. Tarrant's full-colour images are paired with line drawings for the reader to work on. They can either follow the original colour scheme or introduce a new range of colours all their own. Each fairy artwork is labelled, usually according to the type of flower the fairy is associated with.

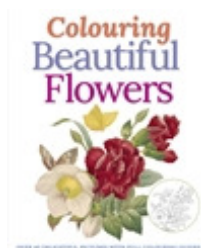

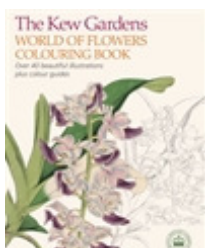
### Author Information

Margaret Tarrant is a much-loved English illustrator, specialising in charming depictions of fairy-like children and religious subjects. Born in 1888, she began her career at the age of 20 and studied at Heatherley's School of Art, in London, and then at Guildford School of Art, exhibiting her work at the Royal Academy between 1914 and 1927, and at the Royal Birmingham Society of Artists. She painted and published into the early 1950s.

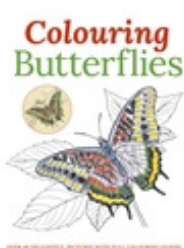
