Elaine Feinstein is a poet, novelist, and biographer. She has received many prizes, including a Cholmondeley Award for Poetry, Society of Authors', Wingate and Arts Council Awards, the Daisy Miller Prize for her experimental novel *The Circle*, (long-listed for the 'lost' Man Booker prize in 2010) and an Honorary D.Litt from the University of Leicester. Her books have been translated into most European languages, Russian, Chinese, Japanese and Korean. She has served on the Council of the Royal Society of Literature, of which she is a Fellow, as a judge for most of the current literary prizes, and as Chair of the Judges for the T.S.Eliot Award. She received a Civil List Pension in 2010.
