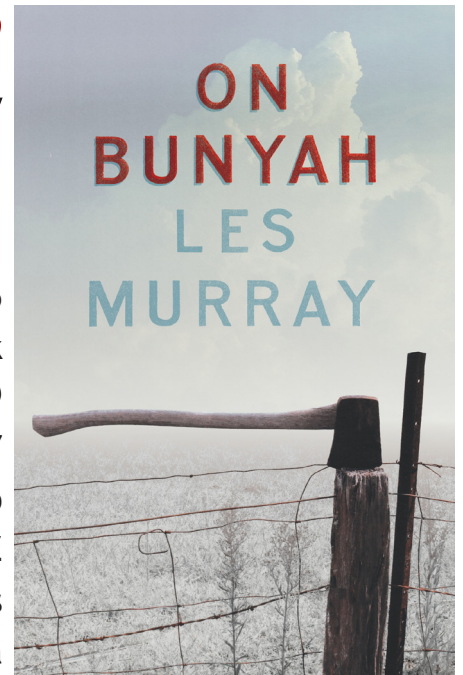

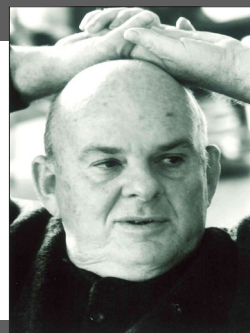

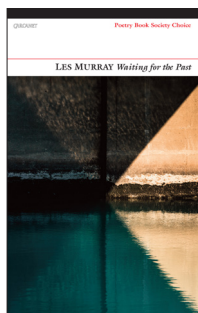

Carcanet publish not only his poetry but also his essays and prose writings (*The Paperbark Tree*, 1992) and his award-winning verse novel *Fredy Neptune* (1998). Les Murray received the Queen's Gold Medal for Poetry in 1999, an honour which was recommended by the late Poet Laureate Ted Hughes.
